

COVID-19 UPDATE

December 3, 2020

Dear Employees of Splendido,

We wanted to inform you that we learned today, December 3, 2020, that **an employee in Sonora has tested positive for the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**. This case is in addition to the cases reported in my December 2 letter. The employee is recovering at home and following guidance from their physician. We wish them a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

COVID SYMPTOMS: PAY ATTENTION TO HOW YOU ARE FEELING

Please stay home if you are not feeling well. If you experience any symptoms noted below, **do not come to work.** Please immediately reach out to your physician and notify your manager or your Human Resources representative of your condition, as you may be experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.

Note that symptoms of a cold, the flu and COVID-19 may be similar; we want you to stay home if you experience symptoms of any of these.

Fever	Possible	Rare	Usual
Aches	Possible	Slight	Usual
Chills	Not as common	Uncommon	Fairly Common
Fatigue/Weakness	Possible	Sometimes	Usual
Sneezing	Not common	Common	Sometimes
Cough/Chest discomfort	Possible	Mild-Moderate	Common
Stuffy nose	Possible	Common	Sometimes
Sore throat	Possible	Common	Sometimes
Headache	Possible	Rare	Common
