

COVID-19 UPDATE

December 7, 2020

Dear Employees of Splendido,

We wanted to inform you that we learned yesterday, December 6, 2020, **an employee in Sonora has tested positive for the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**. This individual was tested on Sunday and reported positive. Separately from this, **all results from employee testing late last week were negative, which is good news**. This includes employees in both Sonora and Independent Living.

The employee is recovering at home and following guidance from their physician. We wish them a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). We continue to work to identify and isolate employees and residents with symptoms and positive cases in order to minimize and prevent further spread.

BE VIGILANT— PRACTICE THE THREE WS:

WEAR A MASK: Keep your nose and mouth covered.

WATCH YOUR DISTANCE: Keep at least 6 feet of space between yourself and others.

WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN: Use soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use an alcohol-based sanitizer.
