Dear Splendido Residents,

As a result of routine testing, we learned yesterday, December 15, 2020, **that a contracted service individual who works in Sonora has tested positive for COVID-19.** This individual is recovering at home and following guidance from their physician. We wish them a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals will be notified.

COVID-19 VACCINE NEWS:

Our COVID-19 interdisciplinary task force continues to meet to discuss plans for the vaccination process. CVS has been assigned to administer the vaccines for Splendido. We do not have specific details about which vaccine will be administered—nor do we know who will be prioritized and when that will occur. It is unclear when or where Independent Living residents will be vaccinated. We're committed to keeping you informed, and will send updates as we learn more.

In the coming days, we will be sharing a short survey to gauge your interest in getting the vaccine.

PLEASE SELF-MONITOR FOR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, you should contact your physician for guidance, stay in your home, and notify the Concierge at (520) 878.2600.
