TESTING UPDATE

As a result of routine testing, we learned **that one employee who works in Sonora and three employees who work in Independent Living have tested positive for COVID-19.** These employees are following guidance from their physician. We wish them a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing these individuals to determine if any of them was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals will be notified.

PLEASE REMAIN VIGILANT

We ask you to continue doing what you can to protect yourself and others, including

- practicing physical distancing (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes)
- wearing masks that cover your mouth and nose when you are outside your home
- good hand hygiene by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds
- avoiding small social gatherings
- leaving only for essential activities. Use grocery and pharmacy delivery services or curbside pickup when able. Limit your exposures during this holiday season.

Our primary focus continues to be on the safety and wellbeing of residents and employees. We thank everyone for their continued support and role they play in combatting this virus.
