As you have probably heard, Pima County has announced some stricter guidelines in response to the steep increase in COVID-19 positivity we are seeing. Out of an abundance of caution, **Splendido will follow the guidelines set forth for businesses in our county.** This will result in the temporary suspension of some services, including

We are hoping to move some fitness classes and other exercise opportunities outdoors, and will of course continue to offer classes virtually via our TV channel.

SALON SERVICES ARE PAUSED

Saluté Spa is temporarily closed and salon services are unavailable.

SWIMMING POOLS OPEN BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Residents who would like to swim can do so, but should **make an appointment with the Concierge.** Each pool can accommodate one swimmer at a time, and aquatic classes are on hold.

PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION

Pima County's transmission rate is already over 20%, and there are concerns that Christmas gatherings will push that even higher. Local hospitals are at or near capacity—**please make safe choices.**

We are urging employees and residents to avoid any gatherings that include anyone outside your household.

We will keep an eye on COVID-19 statistics, and will weigh the reopening of Get Fit and the salon when things improve, based on guidance from Pima County.

In the meantime, thank you for your continued support and the essential role you play in keeping Splendido safe.
