We wanted to inform you that we learned late yesterday, January 16, 2021, that **an employee in Independent Living has tested positive for the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**. We wish them a speedy recovery. Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

We ask that everyone continue doing what you can to protect yourself and others, including:

- practicing physical distancing (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes)
- good hand hygiene by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds
- wearing masks that cover your mouth and nose when you are outside of your apartment home

### **COVID-19 SYMPTOMS**
