

COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we learned today that **an employee in Sonora has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish them a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

SONORA UPDATES:

There are no changes to protocols in Sonora. Visitors are welcome, though visits must take place in residents' suites, and **masks must be worn at all times, even while in private suites**.

OUR COMMITMENT:

We're committed to keeping residents and staff healthy, and believe our collective efforts are the most effective way to minimize the number of cases. Thank you for all you're doing to keep our community safe!

While cases are surging in our area, these are simple, yet effective, ways you can help:

1. **If you have cold-like symptoms, STAY HOME** and contact your physician.
2. Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds, or using hand sanitizer.
3. Practice **physical distancing** with others (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes).
4. **Wear a surgical face mask** that covers your mouth and nose any time you are indoors in public. (The CDC recommends surgical masks rather than cloth masks.)
