

COVID-19 UPDATE

January 17, 2022

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **one employee in Sonora and one resident in Sonora have tested positive for COVID-19**. Note that this is our first time reporting these cases; these have not been reported in a previous letter. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing these individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

CORONADO UPDATE:

We ask that residents in Coronado assisted living refrain from interacting with residents in independent living, and pause on attending independent living programs.

UPGRADE YOUR FACE MASKS:

Please wear a good-quality face mask at any time you are outside your own home. **The CDC recommends surgical masks over cloth masks for providing better protection against the highly contagious Omicron variant.**

Other precautionary measures you can take include

- **Staying physically distant** from others.
- **Washing your hands frequently** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If you can't wash your hands, use hand sanitizer.

Please be assured that we continue to implement infection control measures throughout Splendido and Sonora. The health and well-being of residents and employees remains our top priority.
