Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **an employee who works in Sonora has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

## **WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP STOP THE SPREAD:**

The highly contagious Omicron variant of COVID-19 *does* spread easily, but it is possible to avoid. In addition to frequent hand washing, maintaining social distance, and avoiding large gatherings—residents can help control the surge of COVID-19 in our community by

- **Staying home if you are sick, even with mild, cold-like symptoms.**
- **Wearing a face mask at all times when you are outside your home.**

We continue to practice our infection prevention protocols throughout Splendido. We're committed to keeping residents and staff healthy, and believe that everyone's continued efforts are the most effective way to minimize the number of cases here.
