Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **a resident in Independent Living has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing this person to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

PLEASE STAY SAFE:

The Omicron surge seems to be waning, and we look forward to seeing fewer and fewer cases of COVID-19 in the larger community and around Splendido. In the meantime, please continue to take these proven steps for reducing your risk of contracting and spreading the virus:

1. **STAY HOME** if you have cold-like symptoms. If you think you have COVID-19, contact your physician.
2. **Wear a surgical face mask** that covers your mouth and nose any time you are indoors in public.
3. Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds, or using hand sanitizer.
4. Practice **physical distancing**.
