

COVID-19 UPDATE

July 21, 2022

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that the following individuals **have tested positive for COVID-19:**

- **two Independent Living residents**
- **an employee who works in Sonora**

These are new cases, not previously reported. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

ABOUT THE LATEST COVID-19 VARIANT:

The current variant of COVID-19 is BA-5, which is highly transmissible. Vaccines are not effective at blocking this variant, making even those who are fully vaccinated vulnerable to infection and re-infection.

Please take steps to protect yourself, and if you experience any symptoms of illness—even mild signs of a cold or allergy—we strongly encourage you to stay home and avoid spreading any illness you may have. **If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.**

A good-quality face mask is the most effective way to avoid infection.

- **Reminder: everyone is required to wear a mask in all hallways, elevators, and amenity areas of Splendido.**
- **We also strongly recommend that you wear a mask everywhere you are indoors around others.**
