

COVID-19 UPDATE

July 27, 2022

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **five Independent Living residents have tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

A HIGHLY TRANSMISSIBLE VARIANT:

We are experiencing a highly transmissible variant of COVID-19 called BA-5. Note that everyone is vulnerable to this variant; even if they've had COVID-19 before or been vaccinated, they can be infected and re-infected.

There are steps you can take to protect yourself and others:

- **If you have any symptoms of a cold, allergies, or anything, immediately test yourself for COVID-19.**
 - **Stay away from others if you feel unwell** or if someone in your household is ill.
 - **A good-quality face mask is the most effective way to avoid infection.**
- Reminder: everyone is required to wear a mask in all hallways, elevators, and amenity areas of Splendido. We also strongly recommend that you **wear a mask everywhere you are indoors around others.**
